Lares® highspeed handpieces

Q. Why do Lares highspeeds have such a loyal following?

A. Lares® has always had the reputation of providing small head, lightweight handpieces with great power at very affordable prices with responsive customer service.

Q. What are some of the key features of Lares® **MX line highspeeds handpieces?**

A. With two different handle styles, the Euro™ and Ultralite™, the user can determine which of the handle styles meet their individual preferences as to weight and feel while either head size feature superior power matched with great visibility. Also now compatible with the Multiflex® KaVo® couplers.

Q. What are the benefits of the new Lares® **CX line of highspeeds handpieces?**

A. All the features of the MX line... plus now you have the reliability of the Lares brand combined with the advantages of ceramic lube free bearings. Ceramic bearings offer extended bearing life and no lubricant saves time and money and eliminates the risk of handpiece lubricants getting on the cavity prep and diminishing bond strengths.

Q. Why does Lares® highspeeds have a different head shape than other highspeed turbines?

A. The Lares® 557 head size was our original handpiece and was designed with visibility, accessibility and sound cutting power as key design elements. We have carried those concepts throughout our highspeed product line.

Q. How should I choose between the 557 and 757 models?

A. Which head size to use is determined by the type of dental procedures performed most often in the dental practice and the personal preference of the user. We recommend the 757 head size for gross reductions or crown and bridge procedures. For general restorative procedures or where accessibility or visibility may be an issue we recommend the 557 head size, especially with a short shank bur.

Q. How do I choose between a Euro™ model and Ultralite™ model?

A. The choice is a personal decision. The Euro™ has a smooth hygienic grip and a solid robust feel, similar to most other brands on the market. If you like a solid feel and a handpiece with some weight, the Euro™ is the perfect choice. Many users of European or Midwest-style handpieces tend to prefer these heavier style handpieces. For those who prefer a lightweight handpiece that provides a significant tactile experience, the Ultralite™ will be their best choice.

Q. How can I use the new Lares MX or CX system if I have another brand of lighting system/hose and coupler?

A. The Lares MX and CX handpieces fit onto a Multiflex® compatible (Multiflex® is a trademark of KaVo®) coupler. If the office does not currently have KaVo® compatible connection handpieces, Lares® also offers couplers that will connect to four-hole, five-hole or the ISO-C six-hole style hoses.

Q. What is the cost of ownership of Lares® highsPEEDS vs. other leading brands?

A. When compared to the leading brands, Lares® handpieces cost less to purchase initially as well as later when replacement turbines may be required.
